1 John 2:18-27; 4:1-6

Think about a time when you have been scammed, swindled, conned or deceived. How did you find out you'd been had?

And how did it make you feel?

READ 1 JOHN 2:18-27

- 1. John opens this passage with a reference to 'the last hour' (v. 18). How does knowing the times help to bring assurance to Christians in these last days?
- 2. Although the term 'antichrist' is only found in 1 and 2 John, the same concept is reflected in several places throughout the New Testament. Split into groups and look up the following passages – what does each add to our understanding of this shadowy figure?
 - a. 2 Thessalonians 2
 - b. Matthew 24 / Mark 13
 - c. 1 & 2 John
 - d. Revelation 12-13

- 3. What do we learn about the backstory of these 'dodgy' teachers (vv. 18-19), and how did they come to be exposed?
- 4. What are some of the lies these false teachers are pedaling (vv. 22-23)? Why is there so much at stake?
- 5. What do you think John means by the 'anointing' that Christians have received (vv. 20-21, 27-28)? How do these verses add to our understanding of the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer and the church?

READ 1 JOHN 4:1-6

6. What are the 'tests' that John gives us for recognising dodgy teachers? What is the basis of Christian confidence in the face of this relentless assault (v. 4)?

Application:

 How good a job are we doing, as a church, at testing our teachers? What about testing ourselves? Where are we most in danger of leaving ourselves open to attack?
