6. Why has God acted to save us?

Read 2 Peter 2:1-10a.

7a. What hazard does the church face, living in the last days (1-3)?

7b. What will God do to deal with this hazard (9-10)?

Read Jude 17-25.

9. What "times" does Jude assume his readers are living in (18)?

10. Is there any reason why we should see our "times" as being different?

11a. In these verses, how do we keep ourselves in God's love?

11b. Does this downplay the importance of faith (20)?

12. Which emergency services worker should the Christian imitate (23)?

13. How can God help us in these last days (24-25)?
