3. How is Jesus a better high priest than the old covenant priests in the follow areas:
The quality of sacrifice?

Where it takes place?

How often it takes place?

What is achieved?

4. If the Old Covenant sacrifices only cleansed people outwardly from sin, How then are they saved? V15
5. Why was blood necessary in both the old and new covenants?

Read Hebrews 10:1-18

6. How did the Old Covenant lay the foundations for the New Covenant or be a shadow of the reality to come?

Implications of Jesus Sacrifice:

7. What is significant about the fact that Christ died 'once for all'?
8. What should you do when you are weighed down by a guilty conscience?
9. Are there some church practices that happen today that are going back to the Old Covenant ways?
10. Do these things add or take away from Jesus Sacrifice?
11. Using the language of this passage, How can you be sure that you will be saved and admitted into God's presence?
12. In the light of this passage, why is it important to seek to introduce people to Jesus and help them know about why He had to die?
