

LUKE 19:28-48 THE KING COMES TO JERUSALEM

Read Luke 19:28-44 King Jesus comes to Jerusalem

2. Jesus entry into Jerusalem on a colt is full of significance. What does it reveal about Jesus? Also see Zechariah 9:9-10

3. a) To what extent did the crowd recognise the significance of King Jesus entry into Jerusalem?

b) In verse 38 they praise God and quote Psalm 118:26, *Read Psalm 118:19-29*, What does the wider context of this Psalm imply Jesus will fulfil or achieve in Jerusalem?

4. Why do the Pharisee's respond to King Jesus like they do?

5. Why was Jesus filled with sorrow in verse 41 and what does this show?

Read Luke 19:45-48 King Jesus at the Temple

6. What practices did Jesus expose when he arrived at the temple?

7. What message does Jesus want to give by quoting from the Isaiah 56:7 and Jeremiah 7:11 in verse 46? *Read Isaiah 56:1-8, Jeremiah 7:1-11* to see the wider context and message of these verses.

8. Why did the religious authorities want to kill Jesus (v47) when he was so popular with the crowds?

9. King Jesus came into Jerusalem and people reacted in different ways, what will help us keep reacting in the right way to King Jesus in light of this passage?

10. Jesus was deeply moved as he reflected on the lost people in Jerusalem.

a) How does Jesus tears challenge us?

b) Share ways that will help us have/keep a compassion for the lost?

c) spend some time praying in groups for the people on your *Catch the Vision* list who still don't know Jesus yet?
