# STUDY 1 - The Powerful King (Mark 1:21-34)

What do you think are the greatest threats to humanity at the moment?

**The story so far ...** Jesus is the King promised in the Old Testament, which shows that he would come to save his people by being judged in their place.

### Read Mark 1:21-34

- 1. List the different things that King Jesus has authority or power over in these verses:
  - (a) vv. 21-22
  - (b) vv. 23-28
  - (c) vv. 29-34
- 2. In each of the passages above, how does Jesus demonstrate this power? And how do the people respond?
- 3. From these events, explain in your own words why the coming of this powerful King really is such good news.
- 4. How would you respond to someone who doesn't believe in the possibility of evil spirits or miraculous healings?

#### Read Mark 2:1-12

- 6. Why is Jesus' authority to forgive sins seen by the religious teachers as a completely unacceptable claim to power?
- 7. How does this event help us to see Jesus' priorities (see also 1:35-39)?

## **Implications**

- In what ways are you conscious of Jesus' power at work in your life?
- "Jesus was a wonderful teacher, but that doesn't mean I need to treat him as God" how would you respond to someone who said this to you?
- ! How does the reality of Jesus' great power overcome the things that threaten us whether as individuals or humanity as a whole?
