### **Read Mark 5:1-20**

1. List the different ways the passage emphasizes Jesus authority over the spirit world?
2. Why do the people of the region respond in the way they do? What is their real problem with Jesus?
3. The Man who was demon possessed wanted to come with Jesus. What did Jesus want him to do instead and why?

### **Read Mark 5:21-43**

4. How are Jarius and the sick woman different from one another?
5. Read Leviticus 15:25-30, what was the extra problem associated with this woman's sickness? What does Jesus healing her demonstrate?

6. How do we see the complete authority of Jesus over sickness, sin and death?
7. How does Mark contrast fear and faith in each of these stories?
8. 'Don't be afraid: just believe.' (v36) How does Jesus power and authority effect how we live and face troubles? Does it mean Christians can now expect a life free of troubles and sickness? Why or why not?
9. How do you respond to the things that can cause you to fear? How can the gospel help you to respond differently?
10. If you believe Jesus is God's King with complete power over everything – how will that effect the way you speak about Him to non- Christians and pray to Him for non- Christians?
