- 5. How does Paul show that the way we are condemned parallels the way we are justified in v18-19?
- 6. We are justified through Jesus, not our performance, what is one purpose of the law mentioned in verses 20-21? (see also 3:20)
- 7. We are in Adam's family by birth what are the fruits of his disobedience?

- 8. We are in Jesus' family by grace what are the fruits of his obedience
- 9. What does the 'life' look like that we've been called into?
- 10. How can we change from Adam's family to Jesus family and get the benefits of what Jesus has done?
- 11. How might you answer a friend who says, 'I think it's so unfair that we are condemned because of what Adam did'...?
- 12. In the light of the passage, when do we become sinful and when do we find life?
- 13. How should v21b be an:
 - Assurance for us?
 - Encouragement when it comes to evangelism?
- 14. List what implications & responsibilities being part of Jesus family should have for us in our lives?
